- Tournament hours: Fishing hours will be from 7:00 am – 3:00 pm. No boats can be trailer to an alternate location during tournament hours.
- Weigh in late: Penalty is one pound per minute and up to 10 minutes, the disqualification.
- Safety: life jackets will be worn and the outboard kill switch must be used anytime the big motor is running. No alcohol or controlled substance allowed during tournament hours.
- Boat and horsepower: all boats must meet states and federal regulation.
- Tackle and equipment: only artificial baits may be used. Pork style baits are allowed. Anglers may use only one rod and reel at a time. No trolling. All boats must have a functional aerated live well.
- Scoring: five fish limit per boat, must be present at weight in and no alternations to the limit can be made. Largemouth, Kentucky and Smallmouth will be counted. All bass must be 15 inches or longer. Any short bass presented at the weight in will cause one pound to be subtracted from the team's total weight plus loss of the short fish. Any dead fish will be penalized one pound. No frozen, iced or mangled fish will be accepted. Official measuring board will be the golden rule. All live fish must be released at the take off site immediately after being weighted.
