MO B.A.S.S. CHAPTER FEDERATION BRADLEY BROOKS MOORE SCHOLARSHIP FOR NATURAL SCIENCES STUDY - ESTABLISHED 1997

To be awarded annually to selected candidate related to a MO Federation member in good standing.

Amount: To be determined each year and paid to the recipient in equal installments for first and second semester of the school year.

Number: One unless amount generated would allow for more scholarships of at least equal value.

Funding Source: May include funds from any or all of the sources listed: 1. General funds of MO B.A.S.S. Federation if needed; 2. Interest from capital account of MO B.A.S.S. Federation to be main source of funds; 3. Donations to scholarship fund; and 4. Other sources as received.

Criteria: Applicant who has participated in a variety of extracurricular activities and organizations, either school- or community-related, or been employed in lieu of the above; Student must have plans to further their education after graduation with study to be in the natural sciences field; May reapply for subsequent years; Candidates must submit an application to the Selection Committee; Applicant must be a full-time student (12 hours or more) to receive each scholarship payment; Selection Committee to include: Scholarship committee as designated by MO B.A.S.S. Federation president; Candidate must be related to MO B.A.S.S. Federation member who sponsors the candidate; and Recipient will also receive a Certificate of Recognition.

Deadline: Application deadline is July board meeting with selection announced at the September board meeting.
